# Fabric-lined splint uses

- Great for painful, sensitive hands eg.:
  - RA
  - CRPS
  - Paediatric hands
- It is:
  - Comfortable
  - Lightweight

# Materials needed

- Orfit Classic 2mm
- Velour Fabric
- Velcro and strapping (Durawrap/Mafra and Microgrip)
- Scissors
- Safety pins
- Heat gun
- Cold water spray bottle




